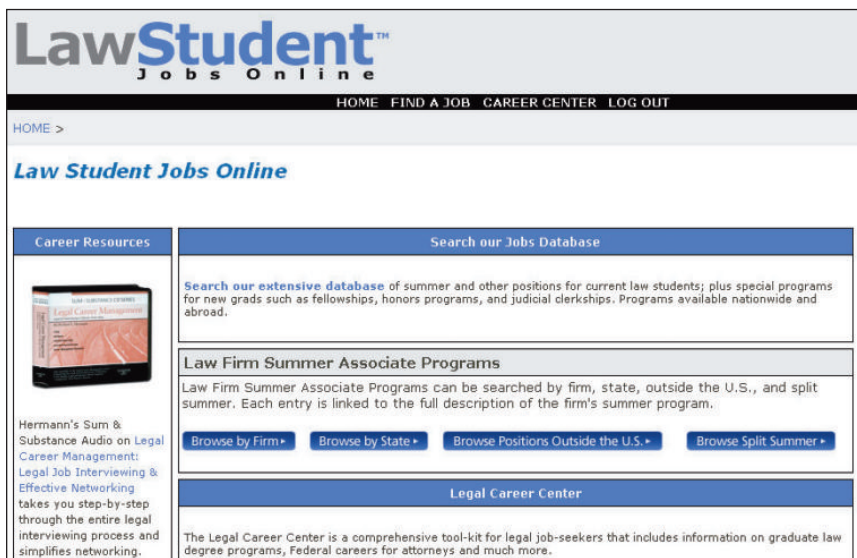


Figure 1. Law Student Jobs Online page

- **Online System for Clerkship Application and Review.** After you register, you can search a national database of federal law clerk vacancies produced by the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts.
