You will need the following to operate WestlawNext:

- Microsoft® Windows® XP Service Pack 2
- Windows Vista®
- Windows 7
- Mac® OS 10.5 or later

Internet Browser

- Internet Explorer® 7 or later, Internet Explorer 8 recommended (Windows only)
- Mozilla Firefox® 3.0 or later
- Safari 4.0 or later
- JavaScript and cookies enabled in the browser

Other Requirements

- 1024x768 or higher screen resolution recommended
- Adobe Acrobat Reader 9.0 or later (some print functionality is lost with older versions)
- Adobe Flash Player 10.0 or later (the Copy with Reference feature is unavailable with older versions)

Enabling JavaScript

Internet Explorer 7.0 and 8.0

1. Choose **Internet Options** from the Tools menu. The Internet Options dialog box is displayed.
2. Click the **Security** tab.
3. Click **Custom level**. The Security Settings–Internet Zone dialog box is displayed.
4. Scroll down to the *Scripting* section.
5. Under *Active scripting*, select **Enable**.
6. Under *Scripting of Java applets*, select **Enable**.
7. Click **OK**. A dialog box asking if you are sure you want to change the settings may be displayed. Click **Yes**.
8. Click **OK** in the Internet Options dialog box.
9. Click the **Refresh** icon to refresh the page.

Mozilla Firefox 3.0 or later

For Windows

1. Choose **Options** from the Tools menu. The Options dialog box is displayed.
2. Click the **Content** icon at the top of the dialog box.
3. Select the check box next to *Enable JavaScript*.
4. Click **Advanced** to the right of *Enable JavaScript*. The Advanced JavaScript Settings dialog box is displayed.
5. Under *Allow scripts to*, select the **Move or resize existing windows** and **Disable or replace context menus** check boxes.
6. Click **OK**.
7. Click **OK** in the Options dialog box.

Safari 4.0 or later

For Mac OS

1. Choose **Preferences** from the Safari menu. A dialog box is displayed.
2. Click the **Security** icon at the top of the dialog box.
3. Select the check box next to *Enable JavaScript*.
4. Close the dialog box.
