

Option 3—Patron Access Content Comparator

Our Westlaw patron Access service provides a customized program that contains legal resources via publicly accessible terminals. The following matrix provides a comparison of the two different Option 3 Patron Access content sets:

- **Option 3A: State Package** provides access to State Essentials Libraries, which includes Case Law, Statutes and Court Rules and Legislative Service.

Case Law

Westlaw has case law coverage for all state court opinions published in West’s National Reporter System. West case synopses and headnotes summarize the critical information: facts, issues, procedural history, holdings, and disposition of a decision that is otherwise scattered throughout an opinion.

Statutes and Court Rules

Westlaw has annotated statutes for the 50 states, as well as historical information about a particular statute. Westlaw also provides access to a state’s court rules and orders.

All Primary Law Library

The All Primary Library provides access to federal and state case law, statutes, administrative materials, forms, and West’s legal directory in a single, integrated research tool. It also includes Law Reviews and Journals.

All Analytical Library

The All Analytical Library combines expert legal analysis with forms, jury instructions, and more. This collection of titles helps researchers quickly review specific points in familiar areas of law and cover unfamiliar ground with confidence and speed. This library includes several analytical sources, including American Law Reports, the All AMJUR Library, Restatement of the Law, Federal Practice and Procedure, Forms and Jury Instructions, among other features.

Westlaw eforms

The comprehensive collection of online eforms on Westlaw generally includes hundreds of easily searchable official forms for state, local, and federal courts, as well as government agencies. Each form is a PDF document with advanced features that let users highlight and underline text, make comments on “sticky notes”, add stamps, incorporate digital signatures, attach documents, and more. Unlike PDF forms available through other providers, users can save Westlaw eforms on their computers and complete them later. Users can also e-mail the form to colleagues and clients for improved collaboration, and, once finalized, to the court for filing. These interactive capabilities are embedded right in the form, so there’s no need to purchase additional software.

Westlaw’s eforms are generally available by state and local courts in a wide range of practice areas and jurisdictions.

This library provides access to American Jurisprudence 2d (AMJUR), Am Jur Proof of Facts, Am Jur Trials, and Am Jur Pleadings and Practice Forms annotated.

■ Restatement of the Law

The Restatements of the Law are principles of black letter law distilled from case law. Westlaw's restatement databases provide a section's black letter law, reporter's notes, commentary, illustrations, and annotations in one document.

■ Federal Practice and Procedure

Federal Practice and Procedure, by Charles Alan Wright and Arthur R. Miller, is the definitive treatise on practicing law in the federal courts.

■ Causes of Action
