

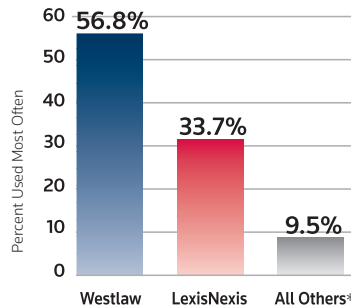

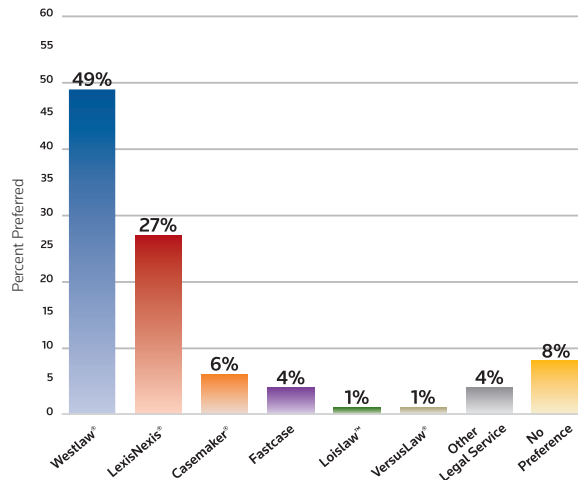

Litigators were asked ...

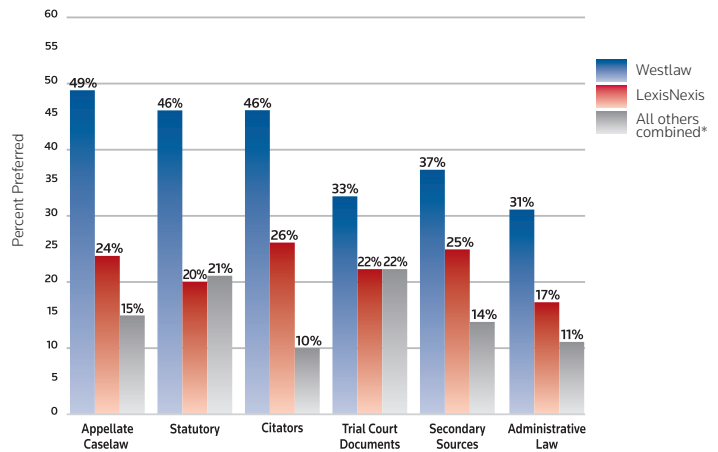
"Which of the following do you prefer to use when doing online legal research?"

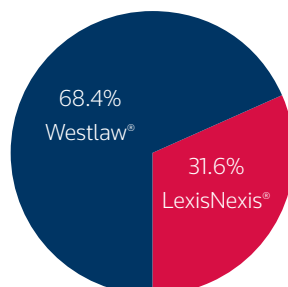
